





GENERAL MEETING

Steph Mantooth, president of the Association of Nebraska Art Clubs, called the general membership meeting to order at 8:07 p.m. in Fremont, NE following the ANAC awards banquet of the conference.

Amy Tomasevicz called the roll of clubs showing 24 of 35 clubs were represented. Minutes from the June 9, 2023, general membership meeting were read. JoAnne Nielsen's name was added as the recipient of the 2023 ANAC Award. Pam Hynek moved, and Mark VanHousen seconded to accept the amended minutes. Motion carried.

Treasurer Report: Diane Noonan reported \$27,907.18 in the bank account before conference expenses. Terri Licking moved, and Sue Oiler Dowes seconded to accept the report. Motion carried.

Mark VanHousen reported the exhibit board found eight disqualinon-member.

Gwen Lewis stated there are 34 clubs in the state organization with 585 members, down only three from 2023. One club disbanded.

Historian: Terri is looking for some missing newsletters from certain past years. She had a display on a table stating which newsletters were missing.

Old Business: Following the banquet, two more deceased members' names were added to the Memorial Roll: June Kehn from Art Connections, and Donna Cole from the Ranchland Art Group.

New Business: Pam Hynek reported problems experienced with transporting and displaying an encaustic piece. It was suggested to develop some guidelines and include those in the rules. The situation was turned over to the exhibit board.

Election: From four nominees, three fications for glass violation, and one new exhibit board members were


elected. They are Shari Mazuka, Elijah Swanson, and Anne Kennedy. This is a four-year term for those elected.

2025 Conference: "Kick Up Your Heels for Art" is the theme of the 2025 ANAC Conference to be held in North Platte June 11-14, 2025. Terri Licking gave information about the Prairie Arts Center as one resource for events and the Mid-Plains Community College as the exhibit area. Other events are in the planning stages. The judge will be Behnaz Ahmadian, an acrylic artist from Colorado. It was suggested to reserve motel rooms early because of the large number attending Nebraskaland Days at about the same time. The college will also have rooms available.

Mark VanHousen moved to adjourn, and Donna Schimonitz seconded. Motion carried.

The Fremont Area Art Association hosted "State of the Arts," the 59th annual ANAC Conference June 12-15, 2024. Thirty-two clubs participated in this year's competition with 285 art submissions exhibited at Fremont Middle School. Registrations were strong, with 103 people participating in classes or partaking in offered meals/events.

The conference was packed with activities including a variety of courses and planned events. Attendees had the opportunity to en-

joy a welcome reception Wednesday, a "fun" night Thursday, and the annual awards banquet Friday evening. Of

the nine workshops made available

to participants several were "sold for the Nebraska Life Award. out," and all were well attended.

This year's workshop selections included batik; beginning air brush; collage and mixed media; quilling; alcohol ink; fabric art; photography; and watercolor. Suzann Beck, a Minnesota portrait artist, offered classes in facial drawing, oil painting, and people or pet portraits. Beck was also the conference judge.



Beck selected David Dorsey's acrylic painting, "The Readers," as Best of Show. Twenty-four entries received Awards of Excellence, and twenty-five entries received honorable mention. Eight entries were unfortunately disqualified due to glass violations and there was one ineligible non-member entry. Dorsey's painting, "The Empty Nest," was selected

After Friday's banquet, the annual member general meeting was held. Three new exhibit board members were elected: Shari Mazuka, Elijah Swanson, and

Anne Kennedy. It was noted there were no entries for the Gwen McKenzie Fellowship Award. Mark VanHousen was selected as the recipient of the 2024 Award.
